Amendments to Town's Ordinance Regulating the Burning and Disposal of Solid Wastes

Pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Section 1972, Notice is hereby given that the Pittsford Select Board adopted, at its meeting of Wednesday, November 6, 2019, amendments to the Town's Ordinance Regulating the Burning and Disposal of Solid Wastes.

The principal purpose of adoption of these amendments was to (a) extend burning hours for permitted fires to dusk (from 7:00 pm) and (b) provide the appointed Town Fire Warden with additional discretion in terms of the size of permitted burn piles, to include the authority to permit burn piles larger than 25 square feet.

Citizens' Right to Petition for Vote

Title 24 V.S.A. Section 1973 grants citizens the right to petition for a vote at a special or annual Town Meeting to disapprove ordinance amendments adopted by the Select Board. To exercise this right, citizens must present to the Select Board or the Town Clerk a petition for a vote on the question of disapproving the amendments signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the Town's qualified voters. The petition must be presented within forty-four (44) days following the date of the adoption of the amendments. Unless a petition requesting a vote is filed pursuant to 24 V.S.A. Section 1973, the amended Ordinance Regulating the Burning and Disposal of Solid Wastes shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of said adoption.
